We can provide trained volunteers to support you for up to 3 hours each week. Volunteers have a linked staff member who offers support and guidance throughout the placement with you. This is a free service and may be provided out of short breaks hours, via your Social Care Team or directly from our waiting list, depending on where you live.

One to One Support

We can provide trained, paid support staff for hours that suit you. All our staff are contracted to us and we do not use agency or temporary staff. Staff have ongoing training and regular supervision. There is a charge for this service, which can be individually funded or from a personal budget. Apply by completing an online referral form on our website or call us for a form.
