SPECIFICALLY TAILORED ADULT SOCIAL GROUPS

Social groups for adults (aged 19+) who live in the West Midlands and are on the Autistic spectrum.

The Friday group is specifically tailored to support adults who have high levels of need and require intensive support. Individuals who have Autism and additional conditions, such as a learning disability, conditions that affect them profoundly (severe epilepsy, mental illness etc...), sensory integration difficulties and/or can display challenging behaviour, are invited to join the Friday group.

For those who may need less support there is a group on Monday evenings.

Activities may include cooking, art and music and there are opportunities to extend social skills

The groups are held weekly from 6.30pm - 8.30pm and are located at:
