Monday club is a social group for autistic adults. The group takes part in weekly activities with a chosen trip every other week such as cinema, restaurants, bowling or outings in the local area. Each session has a theme/focus for all of the day's activities eg. Teamwork.

All activities are co-produced but facilitated by our autism specialists, building independence and social inclusion.
